General Rules & Regulations

1. Rules of All India Chess Federation, FIDE and CBSE Sports Calendar shall apply to the inter school Chess tournament unless, otherwise, modification in these rules.
2. The tournament will be played according to the Swiss system.
3. A team may consist of minimum three and maximum of 4 players (with no reserve). If the no. of players registered in any team is less than 3, as per the rules the team is not eligible to participate.
4. All the participating teams shall compete in their respective school uniforms.
5. The participating schools must send FIDE rating and playing order of their team members by 30th September 2017.
6. Every player has to bring his/her original Date of Birth Certificate, Identify Card as per the CBSE format, X Class Pass Certificate (in case of XI & XII Class student) issued by the board. It is mandatory for each team to bring minimum 2 Chess clocks and 2 Chess sets of International standards.
7. A player shall be under 11; 14; 17 & 19 years of age on 31st December 2017
 - i. Under 11 years: Born on or after 01.01.2007
 - ii. Under 14 years: Born on or after 01.01.2004
 - iii. Under 17 years: Born on or after 01.01.2001
 - iv. Under 19 years: Born on or after 01.01.1999
8. If a player has applied under two age categories he/she will be allowed to play only in his/her higher age category.
9. No team shall be accompanied by more than two officials (coach and manager). In case of girl participants one official must be female. Only designated officials having valid Identity card issued by their principal will be permitted to stay with the teams.
10. A team photo along with the Principal must be submitted with the entry performa at the time of registration.
11. Every team will bring their school flag.
12. If a school, after filling-in its entry wishes to withdraw from the tournament, it shall give a written request of its intention to do so to organizing school. School withdrawing without informing the organizing school, will be penalized with a penalty of Rs. 1000/-.
13. Rs. 3000/- per school will be charged in cash as precaution money (refundable at the time of departure) at the time of registration of the

team. In case of any damage to the school property, the cost of the damage will be recovered from this amount.

14. First aid facility will be available at the venue but the team members are advised to bring their medicines, if undergoing through any medical treatment.
15. The school will provide separate accommodation for boys and girls in the school premises itself.
16. Against Boarding and Lodging facilities, if needed, Rs. 350/- per head per day will be charged at the time of registration for three days in advance including dinner of 5th Oct., all meals upto lunch of 8th Oct. if dinner is required for 8th Oct. Rs. 100/- per head will be charged.
17. Keeping in mind the hygiene of the students the participants are advised to bring one bed-sheet, covering and toiletries.
18. All the teams have to bring their own torch, lock & key for the safety of their belongings. The organizing school will not be responsible for any mishap or loss of belongings during the tournament.
19. Ensure the dustbins are used for throwing the waste & switch off lights, fans and turn off the water taps when not needed.
20. Nobody will be allowed to enter or go out after 10pm from the campus. Do not disturb others by playing loud music and kindly switch off the lights by 11pm.
